3. When is it hardest for you love to people? How can we overcome these hurdles?
4. Pick at least 3 people whom you can intentionally show “love” this week (ideally one from this group, one from church and one from community/work). Think of between 2-5 ways you can show love to these people. Share in your group some of these ideas (do not share who in your group you may intentionally show love to this week). In sharing you are giving people permission to encourage you and ask throughout the week how it is going.
